MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

HEAD LICE

Head Lice are a common occurrence in Schools.
The Children at Raywood Primary School **ALL KNOW** that anyone can get them – [Every Teacher Has Had Them].
Please just **RELAX** and **TREAT** your child/rens hair if they get them.
You must get Every Egg Out of the hair to Stop the Cycle.
You only need to leave one egg in the hair and it starts all over again.
Treatments will kill the Lice but may not kill all the eggs.
Please **ASK** if you need **HELP** to get out every Egg.

OUR POLICY

We do a Regular Check at School if notified.
Once the Regular Check is completed, then the Principal will notify each Parent/Carer of a child with Lice by either a Phone Call or Text.
We then Check again in One Week and Call or Text if necessary.
If you notice at Home that your child has Lice, please notify the Principal so that a Whole School Check is done immediately. This way, we can help prevent the spread. However, remember that Children play sport, play with friends and can generally pick them up out of School hours.
