- MARC VAN with Mrs Sue Gentry commences next Thursday the 15th of October.

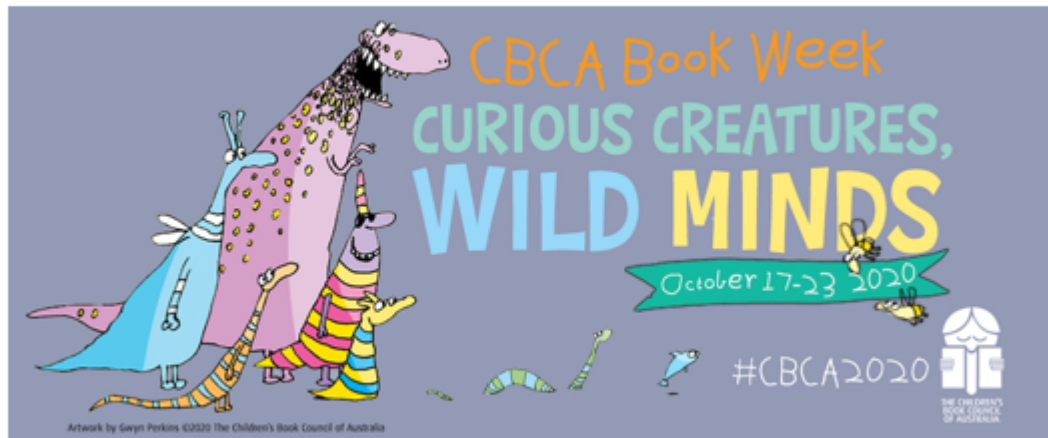
