Hello everyone,

‘**Spelling Rules**’ is our new Spelling Program from Prep through to Grade 6. Spelling Rules is different to other Programs because it teaches students strategies that move spelling from working memory into long-term memory-it makes ‘Spelling’ stick.

‘Spelling Rules’ at Home:

- Your child will have a plastic folder with their Spelling words for the week.
- Every Monday to Thursday (4 nights) your child will write out their words and learn to spell them.
- Every Friday the children will be tested. Any word not spelt correctly will be practised until known on Friday.

**We encourage Parents to assist children to learn their spelling words by asking/testing the words on Thursday night.**

The Spelling Folder is to be kept in the Reader Cover and brought to School daily.
